Preference given to those available for onsite work in northeast Ohio but remote applicants may apply.

Our small, influential staff works with policymakers, reporters, and partners to research, support and develop tax policies that address inequity. Our unique microsimulation model and our research on corporate and individual taxes across income, race and geography steer the debate about tax justice. Join us to make a difference.

You will work with ITEP's Data and Model Team Director (based in Northeast Ohio) to complete the rollout of our new microsimulation model platform. This position on a full-stack project offers a broad range of opportunities for learning and professional development.
