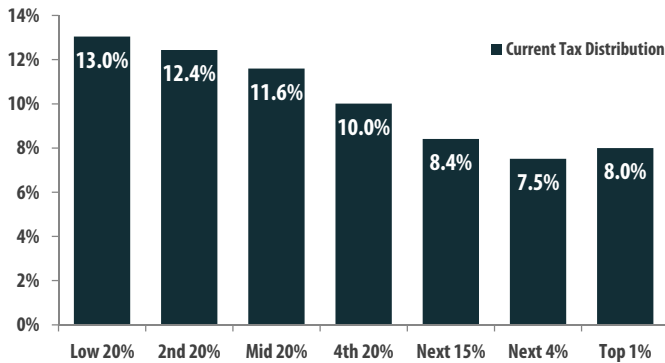


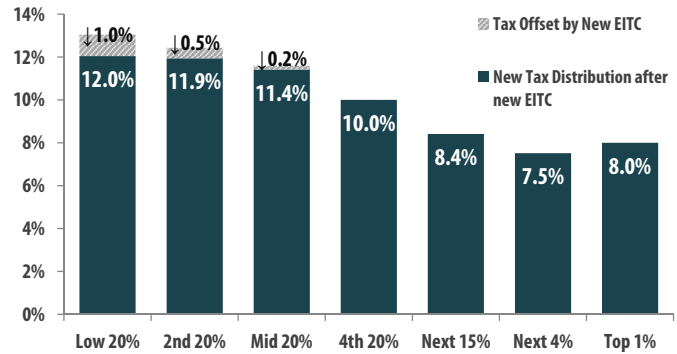

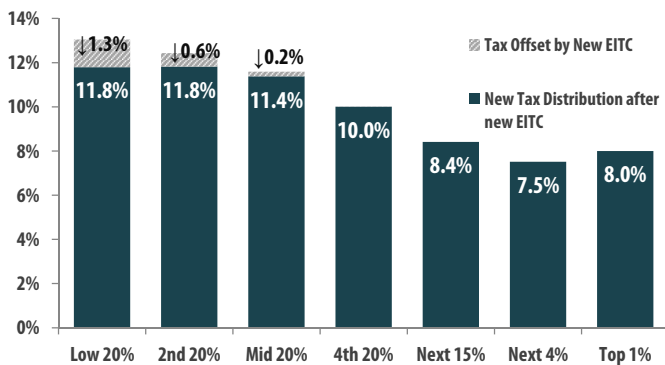
## Current Distribution of Hawaii's State & Local Taxes\*



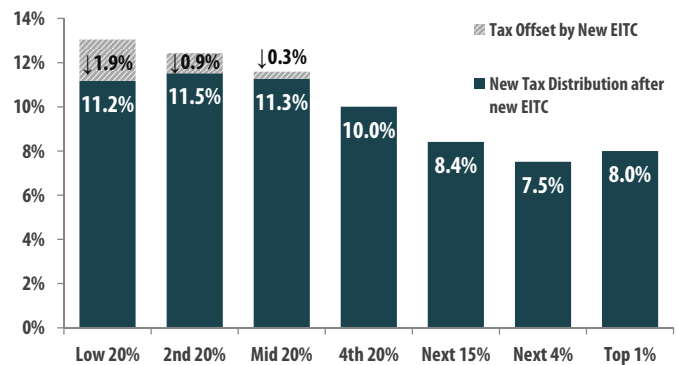
## 1) Enact Refundable 16% Credit



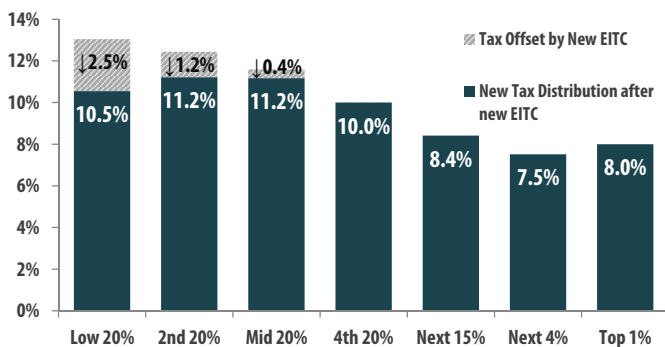
## 2) Enact Refundable 20% Credit



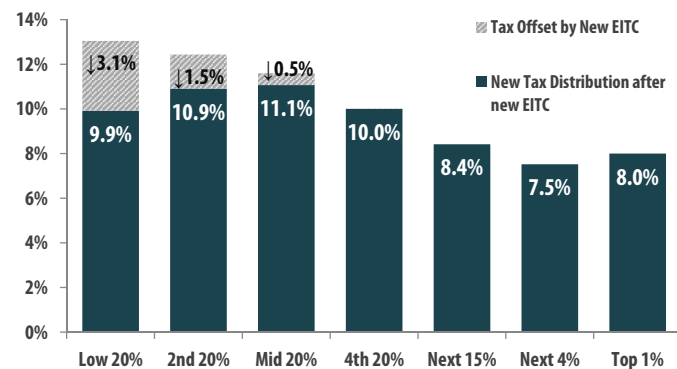
## 3) Enact Refundable 30% Credit
