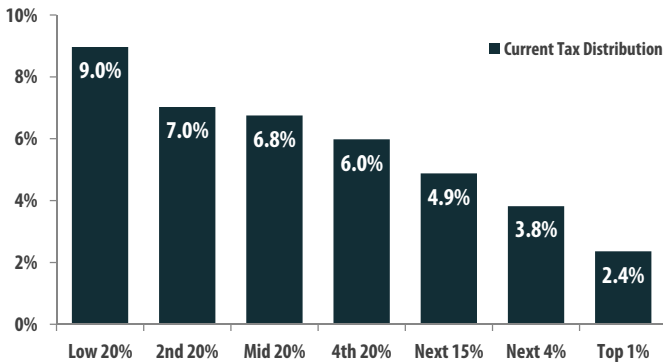

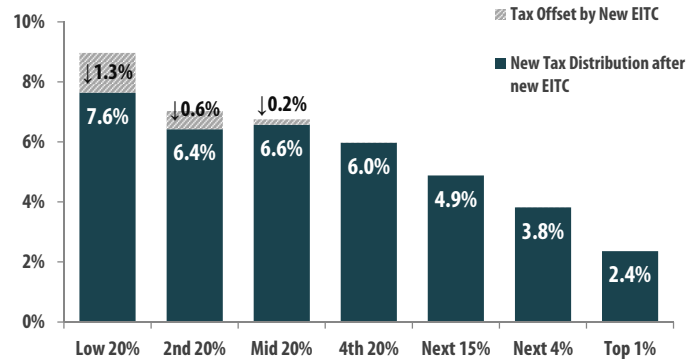

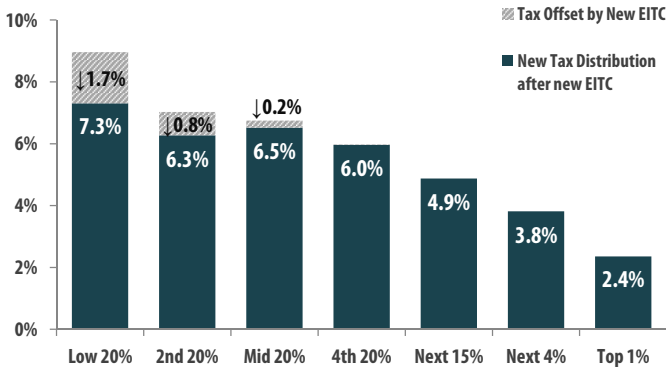
Current Distribution of Nevada's State & Local Taxes*



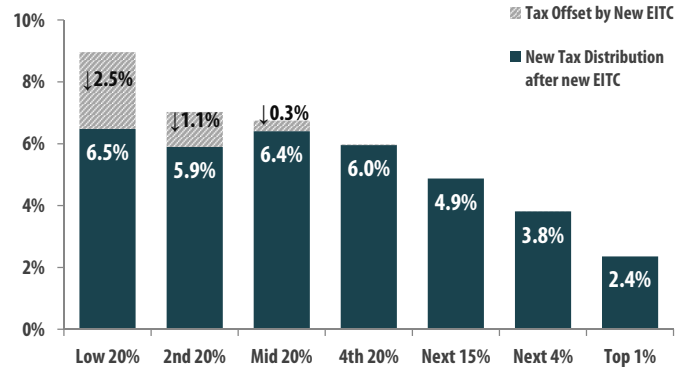
1) Enact Refundable 16% Credit



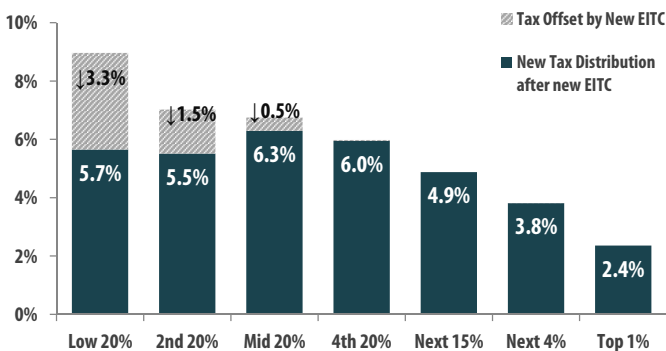
2) Enact Refundable 20% Credit



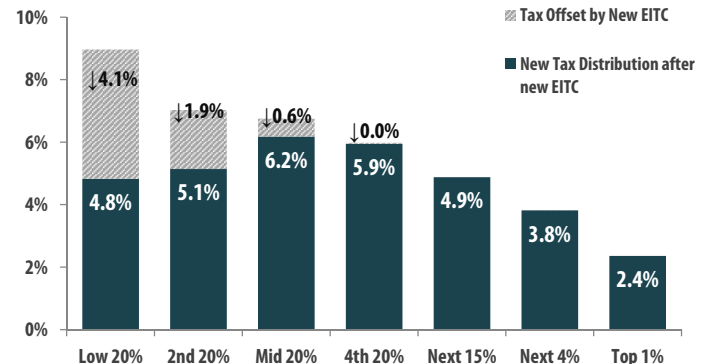
3) Enact Refundable 30% Credit
